V. Announcements

- Learning outcomes will be pulled from Assessment Plan Composer in November. Working with
 the registrar's office to get academic bulletins out at a reasonable time, and keep external
 accrediting agencies in mind moving forward for better deadlines
 - o Learning outcomes come from most recently submitted plans
 - For programs that do full academic year reporting, try to be more collaborative so that deadlines work better for everyone
 - Accreditation cycles trump other academic/calendar year
 - Ability to work individually with more colleges and programs that have more complex reporting structures

- Possibility of moving to an every other year submission plan
 - o Before moving forward would need Assessment Plans to be in a much better format than they are now
 - Every other year reporting could create issues with compliance, however, would still
 receive feedback for every year for individual department and allows for more
 personalized feedback
 - Some programs are on 5-7 year review cycle and goals do not always change
 - 2 year reporting provides trends and allows to see big changes that need to be adjusted before due date
 - Different colleges having different staggered due dates (odd years/even years)
 - 2 year cycle was said to make sense as long as programs do not change
- Looking at other software options
 - o Interest in creating a working group to figure out better software options and using a committee to gain momentum
 - APPs system captures new programs while learning outcomes come from Assessment Plan Composer
 - Look to explore using APPS to collect learning outcomes for new programs
 - Learning outcomes that have to be approved by faculty governance processes through APPS might be taken more seriously as things that guide the program instead of being a separate entity
 - o If making changes to the development of new learning outcomes routed to instructors or OIRAA would have to go through Assessment Plan Composer for each specific school
 - o Would need to draft policy in order to change process and that would take time
- Faculty liaisons
 - o Looking for a Curriculum Accountability Coordinator
 - o Someone who is already in this role or can assist with this process
