

At least 85% of students in RHAB 700 will be able to explain how disability is defined and determined by answering the final examination question related to disability determination (question #1 for 2 different case studies). Students must earn at least 14 out of 20 points on that question to demonstrate competence

Below is the rubric used for each case study. Each case study is worth 50 points (total 100 points) with each question worth 10 points (total of 20 points). Disability determination would be answered in **question 1** for each case study.
