Response:

Chartered on December 19, 1801, the University of South Carolina is home to more than 200 years of history and tradition. The institution enrolled its first students in Columbia on January 10, 1805, but was forced to suspend operation on June 25, 1862 when most of the student body enrolled in the Army of the Confederacy. The University reopened on January 10, 1866, but again ceased operation in 1876 due to problems encountered during Reconstruction. On October 5, 1880 the University reopened and has since been in continuous operation. Joining the flagship campus in Columbia are its separately accredited senior campuses in Aiken, Beaufort, and Upstate. Four regional campuses accredited with the Columbia campus—Lancaster, Sumter, Salkehatchie, and Union—help the University provide postsecondary education to all areas of the state. The following table provides further information concerning the University System campuses' operation:
