### **Narrative**

The University of South Carolina's administrative and academic officers have the experience, competence, and capabilities to provide effective leadership to the ir University of South Carolina has filled senior leadership positions by selecting individuals with clear values and high performance expectations that align with the the institution.

#### <u>Leadership</u>

## **President**

The current president of the University, Harris Pastides, was elected as president by the Board of Trustees on July 11, 2008, to begin serving August 1, 2008. Dr. named the University of South Carolina's 28th president, following a decade of service as a professor, dean of the school of public health, and vice president for resciences. He was the first internal candidate to be elected president of the University of South Carolina in more than half a century.

President Pastides earned degrees from the State University of New York at Albany (BS in Biology and Chemistry), and Yale University (MPH in Public Health, MPh and PhD in Epidemiology). Beginning in 1980, he rose through the ranks from assistant professor to associate and finally professor through service on the faculty of Massachusetts, Amherst, with a joint appointment to the New England Epidemiology Institute and serving as Chair of the Department of Biostatistics and Epide to 1998. He was recruited to the faculty of the University of South Carolina to serve as Dean of the School of Public Health in 1998. He became the Vice Presider Health Sciences in 2003 where he served until his election to the Office of President. He has earned numerous distinctive appointments in academia and public h awards and honors including recognition with an Alumni Distinguished Service Award from Yale University. He was a successful grants writer and obtained a subs grant support for his research activities. He authored or co-authored 48 original papers in scientific journals as a faculty member from 1980 to 2001.

Electing the president of the University is a responsibility of the Board of Trustees. Procedures for the search and election of a president are described in the Boa Laws (Article III, Section 2). Minutes of the Board of Trustees' meeting (July 11, 2008) provide details of the proceedings of the search which actively involved m faculty, student body, Board of Trustees, and others in the University community.

The duties of the president are described in the Board of Trustees By-Laws, page 30 and include the following:

- 1. Implement Board policies, continuously review the administration and effect of these policies and recommend to the Board, for consideration, modifications policies in all aspects and at all levels of the University System
- Assume primary responsibility for relationships with the Governor's office, the Legislature, the Commission on Higher Education, federal agencies and other and institutions
- 3. Recommend to the Board the mission, role and scope of the University System and of its respective campuses, and undertake comprehensive and long-range 4. Direct and approve the preparation of a coordinated request for both operating and capital appropriations, and direct the presentation of and justification fo
- 5. Review and recommend to the Board the budgets of all components of the University System
- Coordinate all functions of the University to assure an integrated institution of related and cooperating campuses, with coordinated educational programs, s comprehensiveness are emphasized, cooperation is ensured, and unnecessary duplication is avoided
- Establish fiscal, budgetary, audit, and business procedures for the efficient and effective management of the University
- 8. Subject to the approval of the Board and within the budget limitations of the University, make such appointments to and grant such promotions in faculty or staff of the University as may be appropriate, and terminate any appointments or employment, both in faculty or administrative staff, in keeping with the gi (so far as applicable) policies as may be established by the Board, and duly report any action taken hereunder at the next succeeding regular or special me
- 9. Serve as ex officio member of all the standing committees of the Board, with full right to participate in the committee's discussions but without a right to vc
- 10. Attend all meetings of the Board and of the Executive Committee, as far as his duties may permit
- 11. Review and recommend action on all legal commitments and all other matters within the province of the Board, including contractual arrangements in accor and procedures of the Board
- 12. Recommend policies and procedures which will accomplish the Board's investment responsibilities and objectives and supervise the implementation of the p procedures approved by the Board
- Sign certificates, contracts and instruments authorized or issued by authority of the Board or any properly authorized committee thereof and all diplomas. signature technology shall comply herewith
- 14. Perform such other duties as may be duly assigned to him by the Board or may be appropriate to his general duties and responsibilities

The review of the president as agency head is mandated by the South Carolina State Legislature Proviso 80A.7 as part of the Agency Head Salary Commission.

The Agency Head Salary Commission was created by the General Assembly in 1984. One of the primary reasons for creating the Commission was for the purposi agency head pay based on performance. Pursuant to that purpose, the Commission established, and continues to administer, the agency head performance procured to the purpose of the commission o Commission also established and maintains salary ranges for each agency head position covered by the Agency Head Salary Commission. A job analysis is condu four years to ensure the salary ranges are in line with the market for comparable positions. The Commission reviews all requests to hire agency heads above the salary ranges. In addition, they are also responsible for reviewing for implementation any salary increases for agency heads. Requests for dual employment for also reviewed by this Commission.

The Secretary of the Board of Trustees is responsible for initiating the annual review of the president. The review is based on 15 questions that assess how well t meeting the goals and objectives established by the Board of Trustees. Personnel matters are discussed in Executive Session and are not part of the regular Boar minutes. Evaluations for 2015 and 2016 of the President are provided as supporting documentation.

In addition, during the regular Board of Trustees' meetings, President Pastides presents "The President's Report" in which he informs the Board members of the poutlook for the University of South Carolina System. Each June, at the annual meeting of the Board of Trustees, the President presents an annual report on the s University System, where he gives a comprehensive presentation on the accomplishments of the University System during the previous year, and discusses the funchallenges facing the University System in the coming year. Also, the president, provost, and vice presidents are invited to the semi-annual Board of Trustee's reterat, the President presents his goals, activities, and accomplishments to the Board, as well as discusses strategic planning activities with the Board. The Boar information, reviews the President's progress in achieving the University's goals, and then provides recommendations and feedback to the President. The Board, president, provost, and vice presidents, participates in strategic planning activities.

#### **Executive Vice President for Academic Affairs and Provost**

Provost Gabel received her Bachelor of Arts in Philosophy from Haverford College in Pennsylvania in 1988, and her Juris Doctor degree, cum laude, from the Univ School of Law in 1993. She was an associate attorney in Atlanta, Georgia for three years (1993-1996) at two different law firms, Savell & Williams and Swift Cur until she was recruited by Georgia State University as an assistant professor in 1996. She was promoted to associate professor of legal studies in 2002 and bega appointments as faculty director for the Atlanta Compliance and Ethics Roundtable and interim director for the Institute of International Business in 2006. In 200 Florida State University where she served as associate professor of legal studies before being promoted to DeSantis Professor, Chair of the Department of Risk Management/Insurance, Real Estate and Legal Studies and director of international relations for the College of Business (2008-2010). She moved to the Universities of 1010 where she served as Dean of the Trulaske College of Business (2010-2015). She also served as professor for the Consortium of Universities of 1020 President Pastides as Executive Vice Pre 1020 Affairs and Provost for the University of South Carolina in August 2015.

Provost T.A. Gabel was named a "shining star" by The Wall Street Journal and is the recipient of numerous awards including the Charles M. Hewitt Teaching Award Service Award and the Bunche, Kemper and Holmes-Cardozo Awards for Excellence in Research. Her work has resulted in more than 30 peer and non-peer revier proceedings, research monographs and other publications, and has been placed on the National Law Journal's "Worth Reading" list. Provost Gabel has served as American Business Law Journal and the Journal of Legal Studies in Business. During her tenure she has served on a series of committees and boards to include to directors for the Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business (AACSB).

The vice president for academic affairs and provost is the second ranking officer of the University and is empowered to act for the president in the absence of the officer. The provost has the responsibility for the overall supervision of academic affairs of the University and for ensuring the integrity of the academic mission o This officer is appointed by the president and confirmed by the Board of Trustees. The provost is responsible for curriculum development and academic standard colleges of the Columbia campus and represents all campuses of the University System on academic issues to the Commission on Higher Education. The provost oversight for all USC Columbia academic units and academic support areas and manages the academic and strategic planning processes for those units. The provent enure and promotion process, the sabbatical, faculty awards and endowed chairs programs, faculty recruitment and retention, academic leadership development and approval of all academic programs, university policy and procedures, and university accreditation. The provost also supervises such academic support service libraries, records and registration, and the university press and will, when requested to do so by the president, represent the president at such times and places a appropriate.

Serving under the vice president for academic affairs and provost is a deputy provost, the senior vice, vice, associate and assistant provosts, the academic deans department chairs.

The Provost is responsible for leading the formulation and implementation of system-wide academic affairs policy relating to faculty hiring, retention, tenure, pror development. She is charged with oversight of USC's graduate and undergraduate academic programs, as well as curriculum development, program assessment, accreditation.

The Provost provides budgetary oversight for all USC Columbia academic units and academic support areas and manages the strategic planning processes for tho indicated in the Provost Office organizational chart, the USC Press, the Office of Institutional Assessment and Compliance, and the Office of Academic Support als Provost. As Chief Academic Officer, only the Provost's full biography is presented.

The Provost is annually reviewed by the President and has received her review for her first year in office.
